## Professional Experience

Kirk studied in Melbourne and Auckland before joining Architectus as a graduate in 2005. He has 12 years' experience working on a number of award-winning public and educational projects across the Auckland and Brisbane offices.

Kirk had a key role in the delivery of a large student accommodation project for Victoria University of Wellington, where he was responsible for consultant and contractor coordination, documentation and delivery under a fast tracked programme.
