Significant Projects

Draft Chatswood CBD Strategy, Willoughby. Establishing a framework to guide all future private and public development in the centre to achieve exceptional design and a distinctive, resilient and vibrant city centre for Chatswood. The Strategy describes an approach to future controls and also identifies key areas for future investment to support this growth. Key issues include defining appropriate areas for growth, consideration of the role and potential of different land uses, improvements to the public realm and pedestrian experience and protection of sun access to the public domain. 60 ha.
